- Baroda BNP Paribas Small Cap fund will invest minimum 65% of the net assets into small cap companies.
- The fund aims to build wealth of investors by tapping into companies which have the potential to become leading companies of the future.
- The fund will follow bottom-up stock picking approach.
- Emphasis will be on selecting companies with strong fundamentals, quality business models and
- The fund will not be biased towards any sector.

PORTFOLIO POSITIONING

- Utilities, Industrials, and Consumer Staples are key overweight sectors. Within utilities, we have significant exposure to gas utilities where we find valuations attractive.
- We are underweight in Materials, Healthcare and Financials. We are cautious on bulk commodities like metals and minerals where we believe that external demand environment remains subdued. Our underweight in healthcare emanates from hospitals where we are selective. Our underweight in financials emanates from reducing exposure to capital market plays which could witness high volatility
- The allocation to small cap companies is at 76.7%. Allocation to Mid cap companies is 16.9%. Our cash position is 6.4%. (Exposure as % of net assets as on January 31, 2025).
- We follow the bottom-up approach in small cap investing which is about identifying the champions of




CURRENT MARKET CAP (% of Net Assets)






